# SINGAPORE MARINE INSURANCE CONFERENCE 2017

Over 80 insurance and maritime practitioners alike attended the inaugural Singapore Marine Insurance Conference (SMIC) 2017 on 27 April, organised by the General Insurance Association of Singapore (GIA) in conjunction with the Singapore Maritime Week.



The SMIC 2017 is part of the GIA Marine Insurance Committee's ongoing efforts to drive and promote Singapore's marine underwriting community through advocacy, education and engagement. The half-day conference took place at the Sands Expo and Convention Centre.

In his opening address, Mr Lars Lange, Secretary General of the International Union of Marine Insurance, alluded to the importance of the Asia/Pacific region in the global marine insurance industry, which accounted for 27.1% of US\$29.9 billion global marine insurance industry in 2015. Sharing further insights on emerging trends, Mr Lange also provided perspectives into how marine risks continue to grow in size and complexity, and the technological and economical challenges that lie ahead for the industry.

Headlining the SMIC 2017 was keynote speaker, Mr Stephen Gordon, Managing Director of Clarksons Research. In his presentation, Mr Gordon offered valuable insights and an outlook on offshore & energy, shipping and trade. Citing the budding One Belt, One Road initiative by Chinese President Xi Jinping, Mr Gordon also shared how the industry could benefit from the prospects of the infrastructure initiative.

The SMIC 2017 was also graced by guest speakers -Mr Warwick Norman, Chief Executive of RightShip Pty Ltd, Mr Joe Venetico, Head of Property Underwriting at Assicurazioni Generali S.p.A. and Mr Chern Meng Huat, Marine Client Manager at Lloyd's Register Asia.

Capping off the conference, speakers were joined by moderators Mr Paul Hackett, Head of Marine at Aspen Singapore Pte Ltd and Mr Rama Chandran, Head of Marine of QBE Insurance (Singapore) Pte Ltd for a panel discussion. Mr Hackett and Mr Chandran are also members of the GIA Marine Insurance Committee.

The inaugural SMIC 2017 was closed by Mr Michael Gourlay, Chairman of the GIA Marine Insurance Committee.
